

## **Education Safety**

## 



- 1. Electrocution may occur whenever electricity is present.
- 2. Allow only qualified personnel to install, wire and operate pumps and motors.
- 3. Always ground electrical units.
- 4. Never use gas piping as an electrical ground.
- 5. Be sure to connect motor to correct phase and voltage.
- 6. Do not operate pump if voltage is not within limits.
- 7. If circuit breaker or fuse is tripped, locate and fix the problem before restarting pump.
- 8. Make sure all electrical installations are in accordance with National Electrical Code and local codes.
- 9. Shut down and lock out all related electrical circuits before performing any maintenance.
- 10. Follow motor manufacturer's recommended operation and maintenance instructions.
